***The City of London Migraine Clinic* - a registered medical charity founded in 1980 - provides access to a team of doctors with a specialist interest in the management of migraine and other headaches.**

We offer outpatient appointments to all patients from the UK and abroad by prior arrangement. We are the only independent migraine charity who provides treatment for primary headaches. We receive no government funding, but work with PCTs and hospitals to help reduce waiting times and improve care for headache sufferers.

The feedback we receive speaks for itself, with 80% of patients stating the service they receive with us as 'excellent.' Research into the causes and better management of migraine and other headaches is also undertaken. Standard treatments for migraine as defined by the International Headache Society have resulted from our studies. Our findings are fundamental to the advice given by the NHS, various migraine charities and the British Association for the Study into Headaches. We continue to study drug and non-drug treatments for migraine at the Clinic in peer reviewed clinical trials. Patients may be given the opportunity to try new treatments in a clinical study. We ask our patients to consider taking part in current or future trials, but there is no obligation and the care we provide is not affected in any way.

Speakers

Dr Giles Elrington MD is the Medical Director at *The City of London Migraine Clinic*. He is also consultant neurologist at Barts and The London and has practices in Essex and London, from which he carries out sessions for PCTs, as well as private and medicolegal work. He is a general neurologist with interests in headache, rehabilitation, neuropsychiatry and MS.

Dr Marcus Lewis MA MBBS MRCP DFRCR DRCOG trained at Oxford University and at University College London. He works as a headache specialist in *The City of London Migraine Clinic* one day a week and as a GP at a busy inner London practice for the rest of the week.

Dr Jane Horti BSc MBBS has worked as a headache specialist at the COLMC for the past four years. She qualified at The London Hospital in 1988 and has worked in community paediatrics and general practice. She currently also works in child health.

Dr Mariacristina Scoto MD PhD graduated from the University of Catania, Italy in 2001. She then specialised in 2006 in Child and Adolescent Neuropsychiatry and completed a three year PHD course in the subject in 2010. Mariacristina currently works at UCL Institute of Child Health as a Clinical Research Associate in the Dubowitz Neuromuscular Centre and as a headache specialist at *The City of London Migraine Clinic*.

Prof Leone Ridsdale PhD, FRCGP is Professor of Neurology and General Practice at Kings College London where she is also Director of Education for undergraduates in clinical neurology. She has carried out extensive research into headache and has trained six GPs with special interest in the subject. Her other clinical and research interests include developing and evaluating community services for people with epilepsy and chronic fatigue.

Dr Manjit Matharu BSc MBChB PhD MRCP is a Senior Lecturer at The Institute of Neurology and Honorary Consultant Neurologist at The National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, Queen square, London, UK where he is also Clinical Lead of the Headache Group. His research interests include functional and structural imaging in Primary headaches, trigeminal autonomic cephalalgias and neurostimulation for intractable headaches.
